KWS Aintree, first out the blocks, is a very exciting Hard Group 4 barn filler, its treated yield is what really makes it stand out from the pack, you won't need a photo finish for this one as it's ahead of the competition!

This variety has delivered consistently high yields across all three trial seasons, achieving 110% in 2023, 111% in 2024, and 110% in 2025. KWS Aintree leads the yield rankings, performing as the highest-yielding variety across all AHDB regions, on both heavy and light soils, at all drilling dates, and as a first wheat. It also offers good specific weight, relatively early maturity, and the added advantage of OWBM resistance.

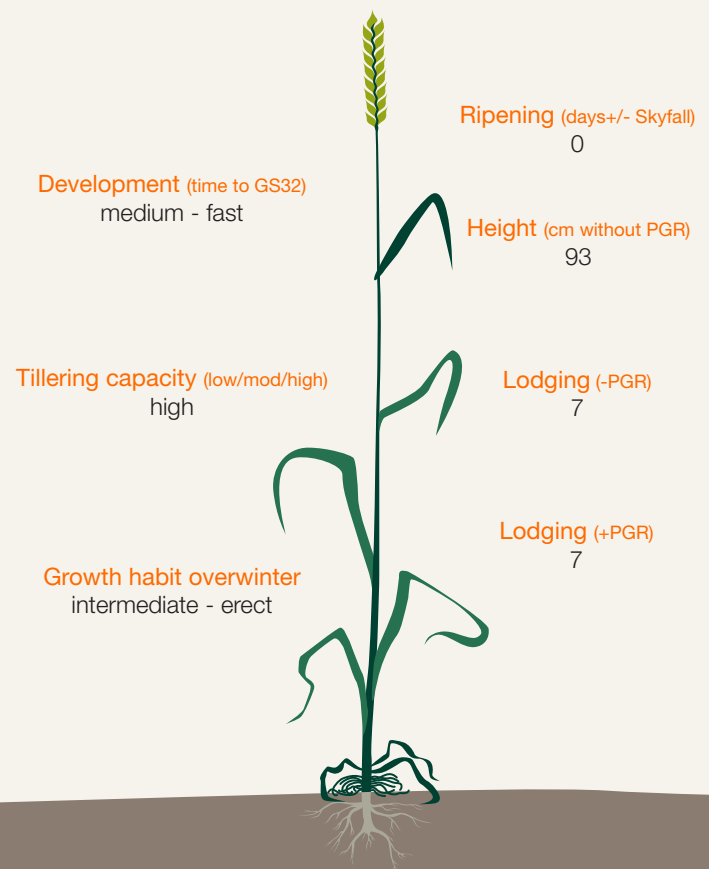
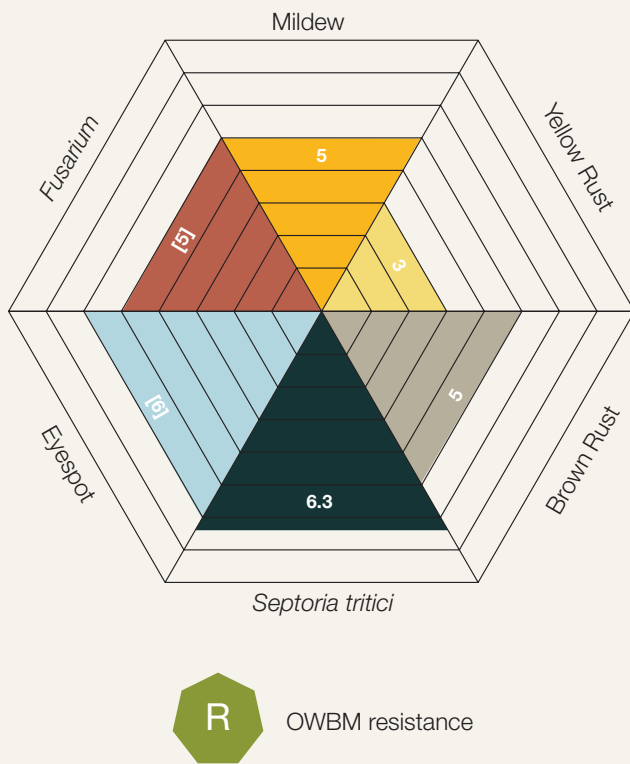


KWS AINTREE yield performance

KWS Aintree is a classic UKFM Group 4 barn filler, meeting and exceeding the intake requirements of the animal feed sector.

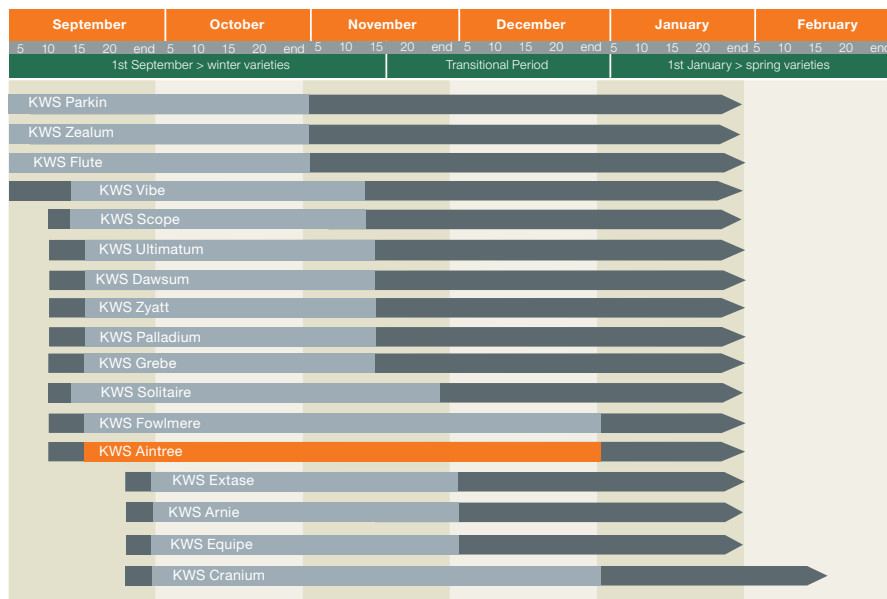

KWS AINTREE - Sowing for Peak Performance


80% of your crop's potential is locked in by the seed you buy and sow. While you can fine tune this with the correct nitrogen levels, using fungicides wisely to protect it from disease and paying attention to basic management principles, many attributes of your crop can't be changed. Therefore, it pays for you and your agronomist to make proactive choices before ordering a variety.
